Mockup Instructions

Thank you for your purchase! Here are some detailed instructions to help get you started quickly with your new mockup file in Adobe Photoshop.

Requirements

To open the Photoshop file (PSD), you will need Adobe Creative Cloud and Adobe Photoshop Creative Suite 5 or greater. You may also use Adobe Photoshop Elements and Affinity Photo to open these files. The JPG or PNG files can opened and edited in any image editing software.


Follow the instructions below to edit the Photoshop file. We utilize Smart Objects to create the mockup effect. Smart Objects allows us to perform non-destructive edits. For example, you can resize an image without any degradation or distortion.

How To Edit Your Mockup File in 4 Easy Steps

Step 1

First, open Photoshop. After Photoshop opens, find the **Layers Panel** on your screen. In the **Layers Panel** you will see all of the layers you will need to edit this mockup.

If the **Layers Panel** is not visible, go to the top menu and click **Window**, and then click **Layers**. You will know that the **Layers Panel** is open because you will see a check mark beside it in the menu. See screenshot for reference.



Step 2

To edit the mockup file, double-click on the thumbnail icon in the layer that is highlighted red. This layer will also have a title that reads "Double-Click Here To Add Your Artwork To...". Do not double-click the layer description, as this will just allow you to edit the description.

If you cannot see the layer highlighted in red, it may be because it is in a folder. If a layer has a folder icon before the title, that means it is a folder, and there are hidden layers within the folder. Click on the arrow facing right, to the left of the folder. This will open the hidden layers in folder. We utilized folders in our mockups to help keep mockup files better organized.

Step 3

After you double-click the thumbnail in the layer, a new window will pop-up. With the new window open, proceed to opening the artwork you would like to see in the mockup. Click and drag this artwork into the new window.

In the new window, you can adjust the artwork as needed. Once you are satisfied with the results, save the new window by pressing Cmd+S on a Mac or Ctrl+S on Windows. Or alternatively, click File at the top, and the click Save. If you try to exit the window, you will prompted to save the window. It is important you do so or your changes will not be saved.



Step 4

After you save and close the new window. You will now see your artwork on your mockup. If you mockup file has multiple angles, please redo the above process for each of the angles you want to add artwork too.

If you are not satisfied with the result, you can always double-click the thumbnail and redo your artwork at anytime.
